### Spotlight on segregation of Dangerous Goods

Segregation is the process of separating two or more substances or articles which are considered mutually incompatible when their packing or stowage together may result in undue hazards in case of leakage or spillage, or any other accident. **REF. IMDG Code Chapter 7.2.1**
